

The Conference on Using the Retrospective Approach to Mine for GIS Nuggets is mission-driven, and the Guide for Papers is accordingly prescriptive and directive.

Papers are invited which have due regard for the terms of reference, guidelines, and the methodology designed to assist authors in preparing papers which specifically address the conference mission of examining how to use the retrospective approach to mine for GIS nuggets.

The Conference Program Committee invites outlines of a page in length, or several pages if appropriate, in which terms from the Guide (or comparable terms) are included in the description of the paper's design, structure, the GIS nugget (finding) of interest, and the contribution of the paper to the literature on how to use the retrospective approach to mine for GIS nuggets.

Current plans are for a <u>maximum</u> of 24 invited presentations over two days, which provides 30 minutes for each presentation including Q&A time.

It is anticipated that papers for the proceedings will be in the range of 8-10 pages, with additional pages available for references.

In terms of timing, the proceedings will be available to all registrants a week prior to the colloquium and conference.

It is therefore required that in order to be included in the proceedings, papers must be fully processed, which includes editing and proofing by authors, no later than January 23, 2016.
